When I first envisioned Happy Hüt Sanctuary, I was fighting for my life. Months earlier, I had been hit with a severe autoimmune flare-up of ulcers. The pain was relentless, day after day, hour after hour. It escalated to tonic seizures, delusions, and even hallucinations. All treatments had failed. I went home to pass away in my mother's arms. I began saying my goodbyes, unsure how many days I had left.

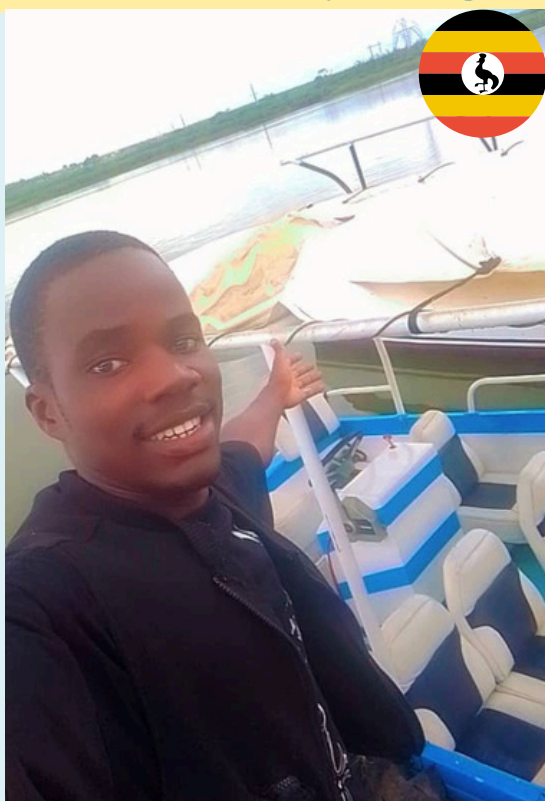
One of those days, lying in bed, I opened an audio app called Clubhouse, and I felt inspired by a conversation that changed my life forever. I stumbled into a live call about human trafficking and slavery across Africa. I listened to women who had escaped, and who shared stories that were both heroic and heartbreaking. Once I heard them, I couldn't get them out of my heart.

Even though I was too disabled to work, pay my rent, or even cook a meal, a question began to take root: **"If I am still alive, how can I use my life for something greater? What is my purpose here on earth?"** That question became the seed of hope for Happy Hüt Sanctuary. Today, because of your support, that seed has grown into a home and school where children are safe, cared for, and loved, far from the reach of traffickers! I am on the road to a healthy recovery and maintenance program with a wonderful team of nurses and doctors. Thank you for being a part of this amazing journey; we are just getting started!
